As we commence the **academic session 2026–2027**, we take immense pride in sharing the achievements and key highlights of our school. Each milestone reflects our ongoing commitment to nurture confident, capable, and compassionate learners equipped for the challenges of tomorrow.

In Class X, the **highest score was 96.33%**, with three students scoring above 94% and a total of 14 students securing 90% and above. In Class XII, the highest scores in the Science and Commerce streams were 89.8% and 86.8% respectively, with several students achieving distinction-level marks. ## ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR THE SESSION 2026 – 2027

- **Admissions are open for classes Pre-Nursery to VI, subject to availability of seats.** We do not have seats available for new admission to classes VII and upwards. **Admission form and prospectus** are available in the school office during working hours on payment of Rs. 600.
- As per National Education Policy, please note the **age requirements for new admissions:**

**Pre-Nursery:** Minimum 3 years completed in April 2026

**Lower KG (LKG):** Minimum 4 years completed in April 2026

**Upper KG (UKG):** Minimum 5 years completed in April 2026

**Classes I onwards:** As per successive age groups/classes after upper KG.

- Walk-in admissions for classes Pre-Nursery, Lower KG and Upper KG will be taken based on an **elementary interaction with students and their parents**. Students of Upper KG and onwards may have a short written test to evaluate their writing skills.
- **Admission test for Std. I to Std. VI** will be held on **all working Saturdays** between 10:00am-11:30am. **Selection list** will be displayed on the Notice Board **after three working days (by Wednesday)**. Please note that there are **limited seats only, and admissions may be closed at discretion of school**.
- **Book list** will be published and displayed on school notice board in first week of April 2026 and can be purchased by parents from any shop as per their convenience.
- For all new admissions, **please bring original and one photocopy** of the following at time of admission. Original will be returned after verification.
  - Two passport size photographs
  - Caste Certificate (if applicable)
  - Aadhar card of student, father and mother
  - Report card, including annual exam result from previous school (Class I onwards)
  - Birth certificate / Aadhar Card of student
  - Transfer Certificate (from Class II onwards)
- **No change in the name (including spelling) and date of birth will be entertained after admission.** Students will be assigned APAAR ID based on details submitted at time of admission. Please do not make changes in documents like Aadhar Card or PAN card to avoid issues in APAAR or Board examinations.
- **New session will tentatively start from 15th April 2026.** We request you to **clear fees of April 2026 by 30 April** and **confirm your acceptance to continue in new academic session**. After 30 April, name of defaulters will be struck off the rolls and Rs. 2500/- (Pre Nursery to X) & Rs. 4000/- (for Class XII) will be charged as re-admission fee.

Note: 1. No additional charges for school diary and ID card issued at beginning of year. In case of loss or replacement, Rs. 200 will be charged.  
2. Tuition and annual fees include charges for all school facilities, maintenance, development, infrastructure, lab facilities and utilities. There are no other additional or hidden charges to be paid later anytime during the session. Books, notebooks and stationery are to be purchased separately.

- Please note that **we will gradually discontinue fee deposits in banks from January 2027. Online payment through eConnect mobile app** will continue to be available for the convenience of parents. We thank all parents who have already adopted online payments.
- Please **do not to transfer money directly into school's bank account through NEFT/UPI or mobile wallet apps** because it cannot be tracked against student admissions number. Also, we ask you to **make cash payments only in specified bank branches** listed below. We do not have tie-ups with any other bank branches and we will be unable to accept requests to accommodate payments made beyond accepted methods or at non-specified branches.

## IMPORTANT RULES, REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES

Please go through the **school prospectus and diary** and understand the school rules and regulations. The school puts a very strong emphasis on discipline. A list of key guidelines is provided below:

1. All students must come to school in **proper school uniform** on time. The school gates will be closed sharp after school bell and late comers will not be allowed entry inside the school. They will be asked to go back home at their own risk.
2. Students must **report to the school at least 5 minutes before the assembly bell rings**. In case there are any changes based on Government advisories, students will be informed timely. The assembly bell will ring at 7:55am for Day classes and 6:55am for Morning classes unless announced otherwise.
3. Students **must not carry mobile phones, earphones, music players, watches, jewelry, excessive cash, or any other precious and unnecessary items to school**. Such items, if found, will be confiscated by the school and appropriate disciplinary action will be taken against the student.
4. All students must **maintain the school diary and bring it to school daily**. Any instructions, feedback, complaints, etc will be reported in the school diary. **Parents/guardians must go through the diary** regularly and countersign against remarks made by the teachers.
5. **Students will not be allowed to go back home in the middle of classes**. Only under exceptional medical circumstances, the parents/guardians will be called by the school to pick up their wards. **Parents must carry their parents ID card and id proof (e.g. Aadhar) to validate identity**.
6. All parents are requested to **maintain their correct mobile number in school diary and in school records**. The school will make calls to parents under emergency circumstances only, so please make sure that the number provided belongs to you (and not by the student) and attend the calls.
7. The school regularly sends communication through the mobile application and urgent messages through **eConnect Mobile App, eVidya and Whatsapp only**. Please do not change your phone or mobile numbers, as you will be unable to get any communication from the school.
8. All students and parents are directed to **maintain polite behavior with everyone in the school**. Any acts of using foul language, violence, impersonation, teasing, inappropriate dressing, damage to school property or any other form of indiscipline will be dealt seriously and may result in appropriate penalty including termination of student from school.
9. All parents/guardians are requested to ensure that they **make adequate/appropriate arrangements to pick-up and drop their children** to and from the school. The school is not responsible for activities performed by students outside the school campus. All parents/guardians should drop their wards to school not earlier than 30 minutes in morning and pick them no later than 15 minutes after school.
10. Parents can visit the school office counters for general questions. Meetings with teachers will be organized only during parent-teacher meetings, and with principal on appointment basis only.
11. School fees will not be accepted at the office counter. We strongly encourage everyone to make payment using online methods, or deposit payments at the specified bank counters only.
12. We request you to maintain regularity in paying school fees. Please make the payment before the due dates to avoid late fine. The school reserves the right to strike off students whose dues is delayed by more than 4 months.
13. Parent-teacher meetings are organized regularly by the school, generally after mid-term and annual examinations. We organize additional sessions for Class IX-XII for more personalized counselling of students who are about to appear in Board examinations. We expect parents/guardians to attend these meetings with teachers to understand the progress of their wards.
